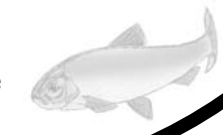
1 Giant silver creatures have escaped from the river!
What they are?

Walk on down the first bit of Wye Street and take the steps down towards the river. Although you could go all the way down Wye Street and back round to avoid the steps if you want.

2 As you walk down steps we challenge you to find all these colours in nature:
Red, yellow, silvery green, purple, rusty brown.
(Circle the ones you find)

These steps bring you out beside the pub on the river bank. Walk towards the riverside path and turn right - **take care not to run too close to the river!**
(Or cross car park diagonally to the riverside path and turn right along it.)

3 Carry along path until you reach some giant birds high in the sky.
Do you know what are these birds?

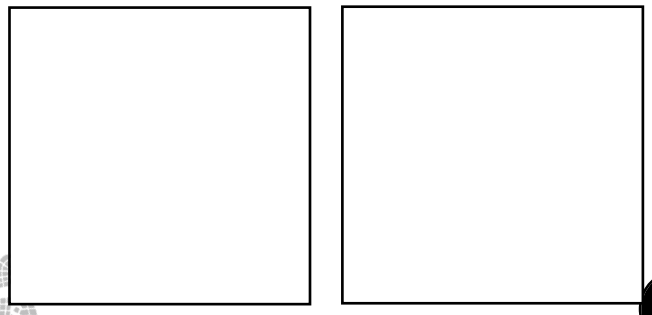


What colour would they normally be?

Can you see any real ones on the river?

4 Continue along the riverside path
How many different birds do you see near the river?

5 If you have a crayon or a pencil, have a go a rubbing bark from two different trees along Rope Walk.



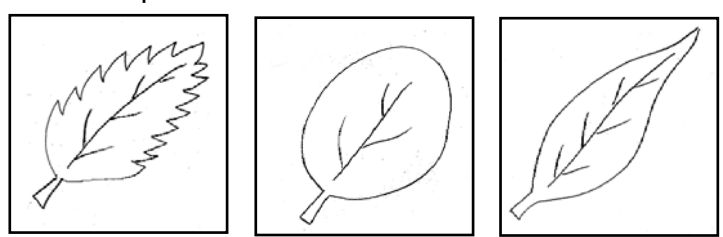
How many different green colours can you see?

Then take the path to the right back around towards the play area and along Rope Walk.

6 On your left are lots of bushes, and ivy...
Who do you think might live in here?

7 This time we challenge you to see how many different shapes of leaves you can find...

Can you find one this shape? Or this shape? Or this shape?



You will come out at the bottom of the steps again.
Walk back up.
