1. Decide what you want to do to raise money!

What will you do to help Herefordshire's wildlife? Whether you take on a challenge or indulge your favourite hobby you'll be making a real difference for our wildlife and wild places. Check out our list of ideas on page 4 for inspiration...



- Who will you ask to help you organise your activity or event?
- Who might sponsor you?
- Who would like to take part with you?
- Where will you hold the event or challenge?
- Do you need to book a venue, or if it's outside, where can you do it?
- When would be the best time to hold it?
- Think about the weather and school holidays and whether your event clashes with anything else!
- Remember to give yourself plenty of time. If you have a good amount of time to prepare, you can tell as many people as possible, get lots of sponsors and make sure you've thought of everything!

5. Consider health, safety and the law

It's really important that all safety aspects are thought about carefully, as Herefordshire Wildlife Trust cannot be held responsible for any accidents or incidents that occur as a result of your activity. To make sure you're really safe you can contact your local council, or The Health and Safety Executive (www.hse.gov.uk) if you have any questions about holding events on public premises such as a school or workplace. For first aid advice, contact your local St John's Ambulance branch or the British Red Cross.

We can then help to celebrate your successes by letting the local press know, and reporting your event on our website and/or in our magazine. 
