



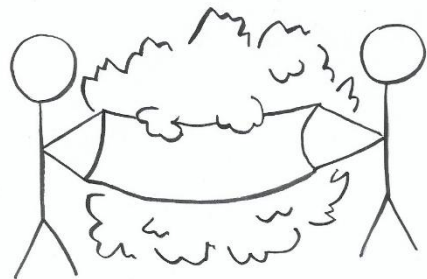
Hunt for minibeasts in your hedgerows and trees!

What you will need:

- A hedgerow or individual tree with low hanging branches
- A light-coloured sheet
- A stick
- Wildlife Watch Minibeast ID sheets

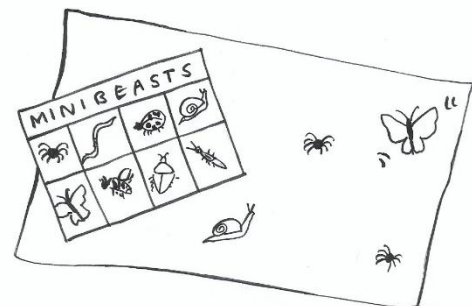
Instructions:

1. Hold out a white sheet close to the front of the hedgerow, making sure to have lots of branches and leaves overhanging.



2. Using a stick, bash and rustle the branches that overhang the sheet to encourage minibeasts to fall out.

3. With some luck you'll have a variety of minibeasts crawling around on the sheet for you to identify!



4. After you've finished gently shake out the sheet to return the insects to their home.

Risk assessment information:

Hazard	Mitigation
Leaves, dust, dirt etc. from the hedgerow getting in the children's eyes.	Make sure the children are looking down at the sheet, rather than up where you're rustling, to avoid particles getting into their eyes.
